



The MARIO Framework supports a long-term Personalized Learning Journey where your child develops individual strategies and harnesses learning tools that will last them for the rest of their educational careers and beyond. Fortunately, this approach also leads to improved grades! The instruction provided within the framework, be it social-emotional, executive functioning (such as organizational and time management skills), or academic will support the student in all areas of current school life. In fact, research has shown that the MARIO Framework improves students' grades during the intervention with increased improvement the longer the students receive the intervention.<sup>2</sup> When students transition out of the intervention, their grades continue to strengthen as they have learned fundamental skills that have empowered them to be expert, self-directed learners.

# IT MEANS YOUR CHILD WILL BE PROVIDED WITH DEEPLY PERSONALIZED LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES.



MARIO leverages evidence-based practices to help K-12 teachers build personalized learning programs that are measured, ambitious, research-informed & evidence-based, innovative, and structured around one-to-one learning. World-renowned Universal Design for Learning expert, Dr. Katie Novak, has helped measure the efficacy of the MARIO intervention at .91 in a six-year retrospective study that is soon to be published. The MARIO Framework distinguishes itself from other special education interventions because it seeks to elevate your child's voice and empower learning to be focused on what matters most. Your child will be empowered to use their voice more and identify what learning is most valuable to them. If your son or daughter is tackling a particularly difficult issue, they don't have to do so alone, because their MARIO Educator will use this as an authentic learning opportunity to develop your child's skills.

For a MARIO Educator, conducting one-to-one learning conversations with students through the evidence-based MARIO Approach plays a key role in the intervention. The MARIO Approach builds strong student-teacher relationships. Through developing strong and trusting relationships with their teacher, your child will benefit from learning in an environment that is emotionally safe and comfortable for them. As a result, your child is likely to see a positive impact on their overall motivation, engagement and performance in class.<sup>3-8</sup>

# IT MEANS YOUR CHILD WILL GET TO HAVE AN EDUCATION WHERE THEIR STRENGTHS ARE LEVERAGED.

It is widely accepted in educational research that children feel supported in a positive environment where they are encouraged to identify and leverage their strengths to achieve success. Studies have found an 11% gain in academic performance for students in programs that measured Social Emotional Learning (SEL) and academic effects.<sup>9</sup> The Collaborative for Academic, Social, and Emotional Learning<sup>10</sup> has developed five main areas of SEL competencies, which are widely used in educational contexts, these are self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship skills, and responsible decision-making. The MARIO Framework considers self-advocacy as a discreet 6th competency as this is an essential area of SEL, which is closely entwined with our goal of developing self-directed learners. Increased self-advocacy leads to more participation in education plans and an easier transition to higher education.<sup>11,12</sup> Self-advocacy is at the core of how the MARIO Framework is structured, as we aim to empower your child with the skills and ability to speak and act on behalf of themselves.



# IT MEANS YOUR CHILD WILL HAVE AN EDUCATOR WHOSE WORK IS DEEPLY ROOTED IN RESEARCH.

The MARIO Framework is deeply rooted in a strong research base. Drawing from the work of educational leaders like John Hattie, Robert Marzano and Jean Piaget, along with the strong research supporting the use of Response to Intervention (RTI) and Multi-Tiered Systems of Supports (MTSS), the framework combines and uses a variety of high-impact pedagogical strategies within the field of education. The MARIO Framework, and its core of one-to-one learning, is also built upon advanced research from neuroscience, medicine, design thinking, systems theory, and psychology.
